Barkley Medical Services expansion under way

Construction of a 23,500-square-foot, two-story addition to the existing Barkley Medical Services building is under way at Barkley Village.

The project, designed by Ross McClure Cornwell Architects, will be consistent with the Barkley District's overall design scheme, said Brad Cornwell, partner-in-charge.

"We will continue the tradition of masonry as well as honoring the district's design guidelines," he said.

The building is owned by Talbot Medical Real Estate, which will lease the ground floor to North Sound Family Medicine and the upper level to private and family practice offices.

Ross McClure Cornwell has maintained an ongoing relationship with Talbot and participated in the majority of projects within the Barkley District, along with local subconsultants Impero Contracting, Geiger Engineering, Diamond B Constructors and Mills Electric.

Construction on the building core and shell will be finished in September, with tenant improvements completed by October.
